There will be a mandatory jockeys meeting at 12:45 p.m. at the jocks room with the Stewards.

Dr. Tom Daniel will be stationed & available near the Barn Manager between 9:00- 12:00 to vet check all horses. Please check in with Mona, the Barn Manager upon arrival for exact location.

Post Time is 1:30 p.m. for the first race and there will be 40 minutes between each race. There will be a mandatory vet check for all horses. From the barn, it is an 8 minute walk to the paddock. The paddock is located in front of the judge's stand.

Stabling: 192 New Permanent Stalls. Electrical outlets at each stall for fans. First bedding two (2) bags of shavings provided (additional bedding available for purchase on grounds: \$7 per bag - CASH ONLY). If you are shipping in early or to reserve a stall, please contact Toby Edwards at (803) 420-8649. PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE SHAVINGS FROM OTHER DESIGNATED STALLS!

There will be a \$50 groom's award for the best turned out horse in each race.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Participating owners/trainers/riders and officials are invited to the OTR enclosure located behind the tower for hospitality during the day. Proper ID is required*.

* NSA pins are considered "General Admission" Tickets. The NSA pins will allow access to the in-field only and will NOT allow access to the Viewing Tower or the OTR enclosure for lunch.

NSA Parking Tags will allow access to VIP Parking at Gate 1.

There are showers and dedicated bathrooms in the lower portion of the Judges Stand for the jockeys- please provide your own towels.

Participating horseman- please check in with the Barn Manager and at the entrance to the Dooley Adams Paddock (on race day) for required credentials- TWO (2) complimentary wristbands and 1 VIP parking Pass will be provided. Additional wristbands and Non-participating horseman must purchase wristbands to be allowed access to the Viewing Tower and the OTR Enclosure. Wristbands may be purchased for \$35.

ATTENTION: ALTERATIONS TO TRAFFIC PATTERNS HAVE BEEN MADE, HOWEVER, HEAVY TRAFFIC IS EXPECTED ON RACE DAY SO PLEASE PLAN ON ARRIVING EARLY TO AVOID LONG DELAYS ENTERING THE GROUNDS. PLEASE USE THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS: Directions for Horsemen to The Carolina Horse Park for the Stoneybrook Steeplechase: Take US 1 South to Rt. 15-501, follow Rt. 15-501 to Ashmont Road, take a left at Ashmont and a right on to McFarland Blue which turns into Montrose Road. Gate #1 is for V.I.P., Horsemen, and Officials parking. Directions to permanent stabling are also identified on Montrose Road- watch for signs to stabling.

The Stoneybrook Racecourse was inspected by NSA Safety Advisor, Barry Watson, on March 22, 2010.

Reminder: The Stoneybrook course runs right-handed.

Turf: The turf on this course consists of a mixture of dormant bermuda and drill seeded rye grass that averaged six inches in height at the time of inspection. Although, the course continues to improve throughout, the ground entering the clubhouse turn, and continuing around to the backstretch is fractionally thin. To a lesser degree, this same condition can also be found on the far turn. Stoneybrook has been fertilized and over seeded a number of times since last year. With the exception of the thinner ground on both turns, the course has improved again over the past year.

Smoothness: This course has been aerated and chain harrowed. The ground is relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 100 (Good) The course had a good feel under foot at the time of inspection.

Moisture: 5(Average)

Notes: The commitment to providing a safe racing environment at Stoneybrook remains evident.

Course Update: Moisture reading averaged 7 after 3/4" of rain on Sunday, March 28. Compaction decreased to an average of 90. Chance of showers Monday night into Tuesday with a race day forecast on Saturday of Sunny and Low 80's. The course will be mowed before race day with the turf height averaging 6-8 inches.
