Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

Scratches due no later than 12:30 p.m. race day with the Clerk of Scales, Mary Guessford.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check by Drs. McCrea and Williams in the stable area between 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Bandages are not permitted.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

PARKING for PARTICIPATING HORSEMEN

JOCKEYS - May park in STABLE area and use shuttle for tack to scales or park in new "JOCKEYS" area nearer tower and use shuttle for tack back to stable (no two way traffic on entrance rd.). For admission to either place simply say "JOCKEY" to attendant. No pass needed.

OWNERS AND TRAINERS WITH RUNNERS - Must have NSA Horseman hangtag or pick up pass at Ladew Gardens before entering course. May park in either STABLE or SUBSCRIBER area.

PARKING FOR NON-PARTICIPATING HORSEMEN WITH HANGTAGS AND NSA PATRONS - Park in SUBSCRIBER area

PARKING FOR NSA MEMBERS - Park in FAMILY PARKING area

VIEWING TOWER ADMISSION CREDENTIALS FOR OWNERS AND TRAINERS OF RUNNERS IN EACH RACE AVAILABLE AT DESK AT REAR OF TOWER.

The National Steeplechase Association will conduct live video streaming of the My Ladys Manor Races on the NSA website on Saturday, April 10. The My Lady's Manor Racecourse was inspected by Race Committee Chairman Turney McKnight on March 28, 2010.

Turf: Uniform, excellent cover. The course will be mowed at least once prior to the races.

Smoothness: Excellent. The course has not been ridden on or driven on.

Compaction: 90-110 (Good)

Moisture: 6-10 (Average Wet to Wet)

Notes: It is expected that the going on race day will be slightly holding for the first five jumps and good thereafter. Due to settling and the addition of a substantial ground line pole, we do not plan to omit the 13th jump from the Amateur Highweight race. All four races will be run over the same course.

Racecourse inspection update: Despite the drying conditions, the historically high water table has resulted in some waterlogging of areas approaching the 5th jump and along the backstretch before the final turn. The left hand portion of the 5th jump will probably be dogged off raceday.

DIRECTIONS: Please have your pass available as you approach the gates.

From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695) Take I-695 to Dulaney Valley Road (MD-146), Exit 27B. Take Dulaney Valley north 4.1 miles. After the Loch Raven Reservoir Bridge, bear left onto Jarrettsville Pike (also MD-146). You will go through the town of Jacksonville (4.2 miles). Parking for the race course is located on Jarrettsville Pike, approximately 5 miles north of the stop light in Jacksonville. Parking for the race course will be on the right.

From I-95, North or South Take Exit 74 to MD Route 152 (Mountain Rd), heading northwest. Route 152 will dead-end into Jarrettsville Pike (MD-146), approximately 10 miles. Turn left onto Jarrettsville Pike and go approximately 0.5 miles. Parking for the race course will be on your left.

From Bel Air, MD Take US-1 south to MD Route 152 (Mountain Rd) and turn right. Route 152 will dead-end into Jarrettsville Pike (MD-146), approximately 10 miles. Turn left onto Jarrettsville Pike and go approximately 0.5 miles. Parking for the race course will be on the left.

From York, PA Take I-83 south to Exit 36 (MD Route 439). Follow MD-439 east until it dead ends into MD Route 23, approximately 6 miles. Turn right onto MD-23 and go approximately 3 miles. Make a right on Jarrettsville Pike (MD-146) and go approximately 3 miles. Parking for the race course will be on your left.

From the North via Route 1 Cross the Conowingo Bridge and continue south. The third light you come to will be Route 543. A half mile farther turn right at another light onto East West Highway. Continue straight for 6.7 miles, crossing both Business Route 1 and Route 24. The road you are on will become Route 23. This comes to a "T" at Route 165. At the T, turn right. Go 1.2 miles into Jarrettsville and turn left at the light. Go 2.2 miles to Madonna and turn left at the four way stop onto Jarrettsville Pike (MD-146). Go approximately 2.5 miles to race course. Parking for the race course will be on the left.
