**Attention Horsemen:**

Horsemen must call J.W.Y. Martin Jr. 410-833-1167 for permission by noon, Friday, April 23, 2010 to request stalls.

All entries must be at Worthington Farms barns and checked in with NSA Steward Representative, Joe Clancy Sr. by 1:30 PM and remain until paddock call.

All scratches must be made no later than forty-five (45) minutes prior to post time for the Maryland Hunt Cup. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

Fines will be imposed.

Mandatory veterinary examination for all entries at 2:00 PM at the Worthington Farms barns. NO BANDAGES of any kind will be permitted for this exam.

There will be an Officials meeting at the finish line at 3:00 PM

Outriders and entries leave Worthington Farms barn for paddock at 3:15 PM

All horses must be in paddock by 3:30 PM

There will be a mandatory Riders meeting with the Stewards at the scales at 3:40 PM.

As a convenience to Riders, the Stewards Advisory Committee has instructed the Clerks of Scales to account for a 2 lb allowance for the safety vest upon weighing out. Therefore, all Riders must weigh out at 2 lbs. over their assigned weight, with their safety vest.

Starting at 2 pm, there will be a shuttle for Riders between the paddock and the Worthington Farms barn.

In keeping with the 114-year tradition of no commercial activity at our meet, the Maryland Hunt Cup will not permit any type of advertising on a Rider or a horse running in this race.

Mr. & Mrs. JWY Martin Jr. invite all participants and officials to view the race video at Snow Hill following the running of the race.

No dogs will be permitted on the Maryland Hunt Cup course on race day, nor will they be permitted in the stabling area at Worthington Farms. Please leave your dogs at home.

The Maryland Hunt Cup course was inspected by Race Secretary Sherlock Gillet Jr, on April 18, 2010.

**Turf:** This course is run over "Fair Hunting Country." The turf varies along the course.

**Smoothness:** The entire four-mile course has been power aerated and parts have been dragged.

**Compaction:** Lange Penetrometer readings ranged from 6-14

**Moisture Meter:** The course received approximately 0.4 inches of rain, Friday April 15. Readings vary from 7-10 depending on elevation.

**Notes:** The Committee thanks Jack Fisher and Shawan Downs for providing the power aerator.
