Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes is to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Directions: From the south - Take I-75 north to exit 293, turn left onto U.S.411. Go 3.2 miles - Turn right onto U.S. 41/411 ramp towards Rome. Go 2.9 miles through a couple of traffic signals - turn right onto U.S. 411. Go 12 miles to Gore Springs Road on right - Steeplechase Entrance.

From the north - Exit I-75 at Calhoun exit - exit 312. Turn right onto 53 Highway -through Calhoun and go 19 miles - to the Rome Bypass - Rt. 1. Go left on bypass until it dead ends into Highway 411. Turn left - go 5 miles to race course on left - Gore Springs Road.

Udated Atlanta Course Inspection from Jim Wayt as of April 15, 2010.

Turf: Ideal growing conditions have continued since the last inspection (7/April). The fescue and bluegrass turf is lush and continues to thicken in density. Turf quality will continue to improve as the race date approaches (4/24/10). The track is being mowed every 3 days and will be at 5-6 inches on race day.

Smoothness: The ground remains relatively smooth with lush turf growth covering the course very nicely.

Compaction: 130-150 (Firm) The course has been aerated and rolled.

Moisture: (Average Wet) The course is being irrigated with ½ inch every 3 days in lieu of natural rainfall.

Notes: The course has been well fertilized and will be regularly irrigated and mowed through the prime growing season. Both turf and overall course quality are poised to exceed previous conditions substantially.

Directions:

From I-75 South of Cartersville (Atlanta Area): Take I-75 North to Exit 293. Turn left onto US 411. Go 3.2 miles and turn right onto US 41/411 ramp to Rome. Go 2.9 miles through a couple of traffic signals. Turn right onto US 411 to Rome. Go 12 miles to Gore Spring Road on right. Follow directional signs. **Note: Georgia State Route 20 will be detoured Race Day. Do not use Exit 290.**

From I-75 North of Cartersville: Take I-75 South to Exit #312. At the top of the ramp, turn right onto Route 53 to Rome (stay on 53 for approximately 25 miles). Turn left onto Rome Bypass. The Bypass will dead end into US 411. Turn left and after approximately 5 miles, turn left onto Bidly Road. Follow directional signs into the Steeplechase grounds.

From Rome Area: Take US 411 North (toward Cartersville) to Bidly Road on left (approximately 5 miles from East Rome Bypass). Follow directional signs.
