Attention Horsemen: All horses racing must be on the grounds and have their vet check prior to the first NSA Sanctioned race at 1:30 p.m. When entering the grounds, please have information with the van driver as to name of trainer, name of horse, what race it will be running in and whether it will be running off the van. If you need a stall everyone must check with Lauren Mendenhall, our Barn Manager for a stall assignment before putting horses into stalls. Please contact the Willowdale Office at 610-444-1582 to reserve stall space.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN FOR EVERY RACE AND PROCEED TO THE PADDOCK AS A GROUP.

There will be food for all participating horsemen at the Paddock Pavilion.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Waste Disposal: There will be a bio-waste disposal container in the horse barn for disposal of any needles, syringes etc. Please do not dispose of these materials in any other trash container.

Credentials Needed: Owners, trainers and riders participating on race day will receive passes from Willowdale Steeplechase for Gate 3. All other horsemen and NSA members must park in NSA Parking (Gate 2). Show NSA horsemen pins, Patron pins, or membership cards for admission to enter the grounds. Lauren Mendenhall and Stevie Hayes are barn Managers. Any horseman or official passes not received in the mail prior to the races will be handed out at the horseman's gate which is Gate 3.

The NSA Hotline for scratches and results can be accessed through the same number as the Fax On Demand system. (859) 288-1066. Scratches will be posted by 2 p.m. Wednesday, with results usually posted by 7:00 p.m. the day of the race.

The course was inspected on April 27, 2010 by Dixon Stroud, Brian Harro, and Barry Watson.

Turf: Cover of native fescue, mostly smooth, some clumping. Has been aerated several times. There are only a few divots which will be filled in. A wet area is at the top of the course, so the course will have to be run as close to the high school as possible. A bare area in front of the water jump will be reseeded with rye after raking and smoothing as will two ruts on the outside of the final turn and landing after the inside panel of the first timber fence. It rained for the last three days.

Smoothness: The course is smooth and turf is good.

Compaction: 70 to 90 (yielding to good)

Moisture: 10 (wet) except at the 5th and 6th hurdle where it is 8 (average wet).

Notes: One of the natural brush hurdles will be removed and replanted. The others are in good condition.
