Colonial Downs will offer simulcast wagering on site on a number of tracks including Pimlico on Saturday, May 15, culminating with the Preakness Stakes. Our goal is to alternate the video feed from Pimlico with our own live races as much as possible over the video monitors throughout the facility. As a result, we will push post time for our first race to 3:15. Times are as follows:

First Race - 3:15
Second Race - 3:50
Third Race - 4:20
Fourth Race - 4:50
Fifth Race - 5:20

This date later in the season could also cause added traffic on I-64 headed to the coastal areas so it would be advisable to encourage horsemen to plan their arrival accordingly. **EARLY ARRIVAL IS ENCOURAGED. HEAVY TRAFFIC IS EXPECTED ON ALL INTERSTATES.** Horsemen are advised to access Colonial Downs via I-64 (although general public are being directed to Route 60). Police will be working to expedite horses and facilitate their entry into Colonial Downs.

Below are the requirements for Strawberry Hill Races horses.

Health Certificate 10 Days
Coggins 12 months
EHV/Herpes shot 7-90 days

Any horsemen planning to ship in to Colonial Downs prior to 7 a.m. Saturday, please contact Sue Mullins by cell at 804-539-3238 twenty-four hours in advance with estimated time of arrival.

Also with the later shift of the entire day's schedule, vet inspections are adjusted accordingly: Veterinary inspections will begin at 11:00 a.m. and must be completed by 1:30 p.m.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are **NO LONGER** required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. **TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.**

The use of raised toes at Strawberry Hill is prohibited. A "raised" toe is defined as an extension of the toe that exceeds 1/16 inch in depth.

\$1,000 awards will be presented to the leading trainer and rider of the meet. For these awards, points (in the jump races only) will be earned as follows: 10 points for first, 5 points for second; and 3 points for third.

\$1,000 will be awarded to the "Best Performance of the Day" by a Virginia-owned or trained horse.

The Strawberry Hill course was inspected on April 28, 2010 by Clerk of Course Michael Pearson.

Turf: Bermuda grass coming out of dormancy with a well developed root system and new foliage (course will be green with later date of event). Uniform height throughout the course. Very minimal broad leaf weed invasion which will be corrected by race date.

Smoothness: Course is very smooth and regular throughout with appropriate banking in turns.

Compaction: 85.6 (good)

Moisture: 5.54 (average)

Note: Five Hurdles (2 on the front and 3 on the back) will be placed on the course.
