The Tanglewood course was inspected by NSA Safety Advisor Barry Watson on Monday, April 26, 2010.

Course: This Tanglewood racecourse has made a nice resurgence from its nine year hiatus. Temporary fencing with safety caps will be used in areas where crowd control will be necessary. Beacons will be utilized to decrease the severity of the far turn, and guide the field to the outside of an old maintenance track at the head of the backstretch. There will be four hurdles per circuit, two on the front and two down the backstretch. The hurdle races will be contested over 10 National Fences at Two Miles and One Furlong.

Turf: The turf on this course is covered with a relatively thick mixture of fine tall fescue, "Kentucky 31", voluntary clover, and Bermuda grass that averaged eight inches in height at the time of inspection. There are a few areas of thin patchy ground that should not be cause for concern. Along with the presence of voluntary clover, there are a few small patchy areas of chickweed that should not be cause for concern.

Smoothness: This course has been core aerated. With the exception of a few areas of slightly uneven ground, the racing surface was relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 100-120(Good) Tanglewood has benefited from generous precipitation and sound management over the past several months.

Moisture: 7-9(Average wet to Wet) Tanglewood is not an irrigated racecourse.
