All races at Fair Hill are run under the jurisdiction of the Maryland Racing Commission. Owners, trainers and riders must be licensed by the Maryland Racing Commission. All trainers must be covered by workmen's compensation insurance and a certificate of insurance evidencing that coverage must be presented prior to starting. In order to alleviate congestion in the racing office at the Fair Hill Races, you may obtain the license form from the NSA office. Any questions regarding licensing or insurance should contact the MRC licensing office at 410-296-9682.

All foreign jockeys must have current visa and proper proof of eligibility to work in the USA or they will not be allowed to ride.

ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

The use of Phenylbutazone and Lasix will be permitted, according to Maryland rules. Adjunct medication is permissible if declared before 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 26. All race day medication must be administered by a veterinarian licensed by the Maryland Racing Commission. A certificate from the administering vet stating when and how much Lasix was administered must be turned in to Dr. Peacock at the Fair Hill Races.

No scratches after scratch time, Wednesday, unless excused by the Stewards.

Attention Trainers: Foal certificates and current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test must be on file at the races.

Rider allowances ("bugs") must be claimed no later than 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 26.

Maryland Million Premium Bonuses will be awarded to Maryland Million nominated horses that compete in the Maiden Claiming Hurdle, Maiden Hurdle, the Filly & Mare Hurdle Stakes, Conditioned Claiming Hurdle and the Novice Timber. A \$5,000 bonus applies in each race and bonus money will be distributed as follows: 60% to the winner, 30% to second and 10% to third.

Drs. Jeff Witwer, Carol Swandby and Kate Papp will be providing vet services.

O/T/R parking will be permitted in the BLUE parking area only off of Route 273. There will be absolutely no parking behind the NSA office.

There will be an O/T/R hospitality area on the upper floor of the Tea Barn. NSA credentials will be honored.

The Fair Hill racecourse was inspected by NSA Safety Advisor Barry Watson on Monday, May 17, 2010.

Turf: The course consisted of a relatively thick, lush cover of fescue that averaged six inches in height at the time of inspection.

Smoothness: The entire course was aerated (Aggravator) last fall. As a result, the course has been left with a fairly significant "dimpled" effect that feels fractionally uneven under foot. These conditions are most evident in the one, two, and three paths on the flat course. Although steps are being taken to ease the undulation formed by maintenance traffic in the same area, they remain a bit of an issue at this time. The ground where the last hurdle on the backstretch resided has settled. Runners will be directed to the inside of this area. An old drainage line between the last hurdle and the ½ mile pole has developed a number of small holes that stretch from the inside to outside rails on a 45 degree angle, and will be repaired by race day. A small depression in the "takeoff" of the 11th fence of The James Stump Memorial will be repaired by race day, along with a small hole on the approach to the 5th of the same race. Many of the timber fences have the typical holes along the base that will also be repaired. Tire track scarring after 4th fence in the timber race should not be cause for concern. These and other minor concerns were noted by the Clerk of the Course, and will be amended by race day.

Compaction: 81-110(Good). Maintenance tracks on the inside of the flat course were 20 to 30 points higher.

Moisture: 8 (Average Wet).

DIRECTIONS: The Fair Hill Races are located in Cecil County, Maryland, just 10 minutes off I-95, midway between Philadelphia, PA and Baltimore, MD.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH: I-95 South or the New Jersey Turnpike South into Delaware. Continue on I-95 through toll booth into Maryland. Take the first Maryland exit, Route 279 South to Elkton, not Newark, DE. Follow to 3rd Traffic Light. Turn Right on Route 213 North. Go approximately 8 miles to 1st Traffic Light (Junction of Route 213 and Route 273). Turn right onto Route 273. Entrance to Fair Hill Races will be on the right, with additional parking across the street.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE SOUTH: I-95 North from Baltimore. After paying the toll at the Susquehanna River Toll Booth, go approximately 7 miles to the Exit 100 (Route 272 North East/Rising Sun). Follow Route 272 North about 5 miles to the traffic light at the intersection of Route 273. Turn right onto Route 273 East toward Newark, DE. Go 5 miles to the traffic light at the intersection of Routes 273 and 213. The entrance to Fair Hill Races is just past the traffic light.

DIRECTIONS FROM NEWARK, DE: Route 273 West approximately 5 miles to Fair Hill Races.
