**COGGINS TEST, HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND INOCULATIONS**

Coggins Test - All horses (including ponies) must have a current negative Coggins test dated within the twelve (12) months and which is valid for the duration of the meet. Furthermore, the Coggins test must be attached to the horse Jockey Club certificate when placed on file in the horse identifiers office.

Health Certificate - A valid health certificate dated within 10 days (subject to change due to circumstances) with proof of EHV vaccination (between 7-90 days) is required to enter Colonial Downs Stable Area.

Attention Riders: Please contact Colonial Downs to confirm what time you must be in the Jock's Room. Rider allowances must be claimed at the time of entry. All jump riders must ride in a helmet approved by the NSA and use a ProCush Whip. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES.

The races at Colonial Downs are run under the rules and sanction of the Virginia Racing Commission. All owners, trainers and riders must be licensed by the Virginia Racing Commission. All owners and trainers must have a current Virginia license before starting a horse at Colonial Downs. A completed application must be signed and on file with the Racing Commission and all fees must be paid or the horse will be scratched. If fingerprints are required (first time in Virginia or five years since last fingerprinted in Virginia), you will have 30 days to complete that process. A Workmen's Compensation policy for all trainers must be on file with the Virginia Racing Commission. ATTENTION TRAINERS: If you are not able to saddle your horse, you must have a licensed trainer or assistant and inform the Paddock Judge as to who will saddle the horse. Failure to do so will be subject to a fine.

ALL HORSES RUNNING AT COLONIAL DOWNS MUST BE TATTOOED AND BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME OF THEIR RACE. FOAL PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY THE HORSE. Trainers are responsible for all information on their horses foal papers. THIS INCLUDES SEX AND OWNER OF THE HORSE. Trainers will be fined for failure to submit correct foal papers.

SHOE RULE - Shoes with caulks, stickers, blocks, raised toes or turndowns will not be allowed on the turf course. This includes quarter horseshoes or any shoe with a toe grab of more than one-quarter inch.

The steeplechase races will be started by NSA Starter, Barry Watson.

Horsemen planning on attending Sunday's jump races at Colonial are welcome to use the Virginia HBPA's sky box on the Fourth Floor, Suite 3. Show your VRC owner or trainer license at the Ticket Upgrade window on the first floor to get a green wrist band for admission to the suite. (No jeans allowed on the floor.) You also may go to the Third Floor Jockey Club.

Purses for these races will be distributed by the NSA Central Bookkeeping Office as follows: 60% to the winner; 18% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 4% to fifth; 3% to sixth. The NSA will deduct an administrative fee equivalent to 2% of the purse from owners whose horses earn a portion of the purse. Runners Reward applies, with all fees waived for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.

Note: The Colonial Downs course will be set up with 5 flights of National Fence (3 down the back side and 2 on the front side) and the 2-1/4 mile races will be run over 10 hurdles.
