All owners, trainers and riders must be licensed by the New York State Racing & Wagering Board. All trainers must show evidence of Workmen's Compensation Insurance valid in the State of New York.

Owners, trainers and riders are reminded to have their NSA Horsemen's Pin and/or NYRA badge for admission. NYRA no longer permits will calls.

Shoe Rule: Queen's Plate or Queen's Plate XT only.

NEW YORK STATE RACING COMMISSION RULES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF LASIX.

All jump riders must ride in a helmet approved by the NSA at Saratoga and use a ProCush Whip.

Runners Reward applies, with all fees waived for any horses which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.

All owners and trainers are required to pay an assessment to the New York Injured Jockey Compensation Fund. The charge is \$165 per start for the first four starts, for a maximum of \$660 per year, plus 0.75% of all earned purse money. In addition, New York State statutory fees of 1% for the backstretch pension fund plus 2% to NYTHA, and \$10 charge to the New York State Racing and Wagering Board will be deducted from any purse earnings at Saratoga.
