Attention Jockeys: All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 12:45 p.m. in the Jock's Room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

A pre-race veterinary exam is required of each entry beginning at 12:00 noon in the barn area. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race.

The Virginia Department of Agriculture will send a State Inspector to examine current coggins (EIA) within one calendar year. They MAY or MAY NOT allow horses on the grounds without a negative coggins.

Glenwood Park was inspected by Doug Fout, Clerk of Course, on September 17, 2010.

Turf: Hard.

Smoothness: Good.

Compaction: Top very hard.

Moisture: No reading.

Notes: The turf is thick and green.

Update: The course received 1/4" of rain on Sunday night, September 26th and 2-1/2" of rain on Monday. Additional rain is forecast for Thursday.
