Attention Jockeys: All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 12:45 a.m. in the Jock's Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes is to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Attention Trainers: Horses wishing to ship to Morven Park prior to Saturday, please call the Morven Park Office at 703-777-2414 for stall arrangements.

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A "raised" toe is defined as an extension of the shoe that exceeds the highest continuous rim of the shoe by more than 1/16 inch. Stickers, caulks and "turn-downs" are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race. Violations will result in a scratch.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary examination from 11:00 to 12:30 p.m. Bandages must be removed.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months." The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds. This requirement will be strictly enforced.

All owners, trainers and riders, who participate in the races, are invited to a luncheon in the tent near the paddock and refreshments will be available after the last race in the luncheon tent.

The NSA Hotline for scratches and results can be accessed through the same number as the Fax On Demand system (859) 288-1066. Scratches will be posted by 3 p.m. Wednesday, with results usually posted by 7:00 p.m. the day of the race.
