Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

**NSA Shoe Policy**

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted.

There will be a \$100 award to the attendant of the best "turned out" horse in each race.

**Scratches/Results Hotline**

The NSA Hotline for scratches and results can be accessed through the same number as the Fax On Demand system (859) 288-1066. Scratches will be posted by 3 p.m. Wednesday, with results usually posted by 7:00 p.m. the day of the race.

**Turf:** This course is run over "fair hunting country." and as such is in excellent shape with thick, lush grass cover that averaged 6" at time of inspection.

**Smoothness:** The ground at Genesee Valley is smoother each year. Abundant summer rains and regular maintenance have made this course better each year.

**Compaction:** 100 (good)

**Moisture:** 8 (average wet)

**Notes:** Course was aerated Monday morning, October 4, with soft rains Monday and into Tuesday morning.
