ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED AT THE BARN, ASSEMBLE IN NUMERIC ORDER IN THE BARN PADDOCK PRIOR TO EACH RACE AND PROCEED TO THE TOWER PADDOCK AS A GROUP. TRAINERS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHEDULE THAT WILL BE POSTED IN THE BARN AREA.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

NSA Shoe Policy

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted.

All vans arriving Friday, Oct. 22 must use Gate 2 off Route 202. Security will continuously check Gate for late arrivals.

Current NSA credentials will be honored for admission to the racecourse grounds. Horsemen will be issued paddock passes upon request to Patti Tegenborg via email (ptegenborg@farhillsrace.org) or telephone (908-234-9115). Far Hills Course Inspection

Turf: The entire turf course at Moorland Farm was aerated, slice seeded, and sand top dressed immediately after the Far Hills Race Meeting Association's Fall 2009 meet. Spring 2010 operations included divot repair, fertilization, rolling and aeration. The entire turf received supplemental irrigation as needed throughout the growing season to maintain balanced moisture levels in the upper 10" soil profile. Weekly application rates and frequency were adjusted to insure one inch of water, applied either through rainfall or the irrigation system, during May and June. Two inches of water per week was applied in July and August. One inch per week was applied for September through last week. Weekly mowing, weed control, and an aggressive IPM program have continued to keep the quality and consistency of the turf at the highest possible level. The turf is thick, lush, and has a clipped top-out height of 6-8". There are no bare or thin areas in any part of the timber or hurdle courses.

Smoothness: The course has been rolled, aerated, and hand walked with root zone mix to fill any divots or cupping. The surface is smooth and consistent with a giving yet firm resiliency. There is NO vehicular traffic allowed on the course at any time.

Compaction: Weekly readings taken with a Lang Penetrometer put the turf course at an average of 125.

Directions:

From Route 78: Take Exit 29 to Route 287 North to Exit 22B (Route 202/206 North). Bear right at Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Bernardsville via Route 202 South: At railroad tracks in Far Hills, turn left onto Liberty Corner Road (county #512) to Gate #4 or Gate #5.

From the South via Route 287: Take Exit 22B. Turn right onto Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From the North via Route 287: Take Exit 22 to Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Chester/Peapack Area via Route 206 South: Turn left onto Pottersville Road (County #512) to Main Street in Gladstone. Turn right onto Main Street in Gladstone (still County #512). Follow into Far Hills. Turn left onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Basking Ridge & Liberty Corner via Liberty Corner Road (County #512): Proceed North on Liberty Corner Road (County #512), turn left and proceed to Gate #4 or Gate #5.
