made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.  
Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes  
are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE  
REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE  
IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

The Block House course was inspected by Co-Chairman Mark  
Lehner on Monday, April 5, 2010.

**Turf:** There have been several seedings of rye grass on the course  
as well as other basic maintenance to the course. It had an  
application of herbicide on April 1 for the purpose of controlling  
weeds. It looked in very good shape today. There are some days of  
precipitation still forecast to occur between now and the day of the  
race, especially on about April 8th and 9th.

**Smoothness:** Report is basically the same as last year. There was a major drainage pipe repair conducted in early March at the Mahler Barn end, and the repair spot has not completely grassed over as of today. It should have mulch covering on the day of the race.

**Compaction & Moisture:** Tests were conducted around the track with the following averages: Moisture Avg: 7-8 (Avg Wet) Compaction Avg: 135 (Firm)

"Repaired Pipe Spot" is on the Mahler end on the first turn where the repairs on the collapsed stream pipe are still visible. There will be mulch on this for 2010.

"Repaired Spot 2009" is an approximate 20'x20' spot where a drainage problem was corrected in 2009 and new grass planted. This is a non issue this year.

**Comments:** The course appeared in very good shape today and looks to be ready for the race. The facility is fire ant free, and from my inspection today as well as walking over the property extensively over the past week for another horse show on site, I saw no evidence of fire ants anywhere.
