All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 12:45 p.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary examination in the stable area for all entries with Dr. Kay Stewart which must be completed by 1:00 p.m. Bandages must be removed. Your cooperation is appreciated.

ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED IN THE VAN AREA. There will be a shuttle going from the scales to the van area.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

#### NSA Shoe Policy

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted.

The course was inspected on October 26, 2010.

**Turf:** Mostly fescue, 3 to 4 inches in length.

**Smoothness:** The course has been spread with mushroom soil, decompacted and rolled. The course is considered "fair hunting country".

**Compaction:** Lower ground 80-100 (Yielding to Good) / Higher ground 120-140 (Good to Firm)

**Moisture:** Lower ground 8-10 (Average Wet to Wet) / Higher ground 4-6 (Average Dry to Average)

**Notes:** The course made a great comeback from earlier drought conditions this summer. Substantial rainfall in early October helped significantly. More rain is predicted this week.

### Directions:

From West Chester, PA – Route 202 South to Route 926 (Street Road) West. Follow Route 926 across Route 82, and continue to intersection of Newark Road. For **Gate #1:** Turn right onto Newark Road and go 1/4 mile to entrance on left. For **Gate #2:** Stay on Route 926 West approximately 1/4 mile to entrance on right. For **Gate #3:** Stay on Newark Road to Route 842, turn left at stop sign and go to entrance at Stone Barn on the left.

From New Jersey or New York – NJ Turnpike to Route 295 South. Cross Commodore Barry Bridge and follow I-95 South to Route 322 West to Route 1 South and follow to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) onto Newark Road for 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow directions above for appropriate gate.

From Maryland – I-95 North to Exit 93 (Port Deposit). Follow Route 275 North to Route 276 North to Route 1. Follow Route 1 North to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn left (North) onto Newark Road and follow 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow directions above for appropriate gate.

From Delaware – Route 52 North to Route 1. Left (South) on Route 1 to Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) onto Newark Road and follow 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road). Follow directions above for appropriate gate.

From Lancaster – Route 41 South to Route 926 East (Street Road) and follow 5-6 miles. Gate #2 will be on the right. Continue past Gate #2 to stop sign, turn left onto Newark road and follow directions above for Gates #1 and #3.

From Harrisburg – Pennsylvania Turnpike to Downingtown Exit. Take Route 202 South to Route 1. Turn right (South) on Route 1 to the Toughkenamon Exit. Turn right (North) onto Newark Road and follow 3-4 miles to intersection of Route 926 (Street Road) and Newark Road. Follow directions above for appropriate gate.
