The Aiken Racecourse was inspected by Jill Thomas (Board Member) of the Aiken Steeplechase Association on March 11, 2011.

Turf: The course is a mixture of dormant Bermuda grass, drill seeded rye and over seeded rye grass. The grass is thick and healthy and makes for a lush, green turf course. Lately we have had some soaking rains and that along with the sprinkler system has put the course in very good shape this spring and it should only improve in the coming days.

Smoothness: The course is relatively smooth throughout. There has been very limited use of the course this winter.

Compaction: 80 - Yielding. Compaction and moisture measurements were taken at 1/16th mile increments on both the flat and steeplechase areas of the course.

Moisture: Moisture: 7.8 - Average Wet

Notes: The course was rolled five days ago.
