Directions: From the south - Take I-75 north to exit 293, turn left onto U.S.411. Go 3.2 miles - Turn right onto U.S. 41/411 ramp towards Rome. Go 2.9 miles through a couple of traffic signals - turn right onto U.S. 411. Go 12 miles to Gore Springs Road on right - Steeplechase Entrance.

From the north - Exit I-75 at Calhoun exit - exit 312. Turn right onto 53 Highway -through Calhoun and go 19 miles - to the Rome Bypass - Rt. 1. Go left on bypass until it dead ends into Highway 411. Turn left - go 5 miles to race course on left - Gore Springs Road.

The Atlanta course was inspected on March 27, 2011 by R. Barry Watson, Dick Washburn and Jim Wayt.

Turf: The turf on this course has improved again since last year's dramatic improvement. Most of the chickweed and henbit that inhabited much of the course has been eliminated and replaced with new fescue. Although the new grass cover remains fractionally thin, patchy and immature in some areas, Kingston Downs should improve dramatically over the next three weeks of prime spring growing conditions. The typical areas of thin ground down the backstretch of the course were still an issue, but were well on the way to renewed substance. These conditions were also noticed in the homestretch, but should not be cause for concern.

Smoothness: With the exception of the spring clumping characteristic of patchy areas of fescue, the ground is relatively smooth throughout.

Compaction: 100(Good) This course has been aerated and rolled and has a very good feel under foot.

Moisture: 8-10(Average Wet to Wet) Kingston Downs will be irrigated as needed until race day.

Note: Kingston Downs continues to exhibit the benefits of a renewed emphasis on proactive management and maintenance.

Update on the Atlanta course:

Rainfall/Irrigation - We have had good regular seasonal rains and have supplemented with irrigation to minimum 1.5 inches per week. We are irrigating today and expect 0.50 inch of rainfall tonight. We will also irrigate again on Thursday expect some rain Thursday and Friday here. Bottom line: we have maintained good soil moisture and will continue to do so through this week and onward.

Turf - the fescue/bluegrass has filled out well with the last liquid nitrogen application and good weather. There are still a few small patchy spots in the middle of the back and home stretches but definitely an improvement over last year. The chickweed is 97% gone and going fast with recent hot weather - so not an issue whatsoever.

Compaction - remains consistent with your findings on 27/March - so again even better than last year.

Weather for Saturday 16/April - we are expecting highs in the low 60's, partly sunny with a 20% chance of rain.

Directions:

From I-75 South of Cartersville (Atlanta Area): Take I-75 North to Exit 293. Turn left onto US 411. Go 3.2 miles and turn right onto US 41/411 ramp to Rome. Go 2.9 miles through a couple of traffic signals. Turn right onto US 411 to Rome. Go 12 miles to Gore Spring Road on right. Follow directional signs. **Note: Georgia State Route 20 will be detoured Race Day. Do not use Exit 290.**

From I-75 North of Cartersville: Take I-75 South to Exit #312. At the top of the ramp, turn right onto Route 53 to Rome (stay on 53 for approximately 25 miles). Turn left onto Rome Bypass. The Bypass will dead end into US 411. Turn left and after approximately 5 miles, turn left onto Bidly Road. Follow directional signs into the Steeplechase grounds.

From Rome Area: Take US 411 North (toward Cartersville) to Bidly Road on left (approximately 5 miles from East Rome Bypass). Follow directional signs.
