A pre-race veterinary exam is required of each entry beginning at 1:30 p.m. at the stable area by Drs. Rachel Westerlund and Cooper Williams. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

Scratches are due no later than 2:15 p.m. with the Clerk of Scales, Mary Guessford.

Officials meeting will be held at 2:15 p.m. in the paddock.

There will be a mandatory jockeys meeting at 2:30 p.m. at the riders tent.

Special Events Medical Services (SEMS) provides field trauma support and works within the parameters of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS). Note: SEMS utilizes Gator vehicles specifically modified for field trauma use. A team of qualified physicians is present to supervise medical activities and to perform examinations following a fall.

Western Run Plate is run between blue and white flags.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

There will be a post race reception and viewing of race video for officials and all horsemen named in the program at the residence of Mr. & Mrs. Peter Fenwick, 2315 Geist Rd., immediately following the last race.

The Grand National Steeplechase course was inspected on April 11, 2011 by Peter R. Fenwick and Priscilla Hoblitzell.

Turf: Uniform mixture of bluegrass and fescue throughout, with the exception of area from fence eight to nine where the turf is less dense. Portions of the course will be mowed twice and the entire course will be mowed at least once.

Smoothness: Entire course has been rolled with a Cambridge roller, including concentration on paddock and work areas. Smoothness is good to excellent.

Compaction: 104 - 110 (Good)

Moisture: 7 - 10 (Average Wet)

Notes: Course is over open hunt country. Other than one area of thin turf, course is in very good condition. Wet areas have high compaction factors.
