ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Brian Jarvis).

NEW HORSEMEN PARKING: New Parking for Owners/Trainers/Riders: Come in to van area and follow signs to new parking area.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

A luncheon and cocktail party will be available for the participants of today's races (owners, trainers and riders) in the Official Luncheon Tent located near the stables and paddock.

NSA badges must be VISIBLE to expedite you through the Reserved Enclosure Gate. Owners, Trainers and riders - there are Member boxes available for your viewing of the races located on the top in front of the tents.

Fruit, Water & Gatorade available for all grooms.

Schooling will not be permitted before, during, or after the races.

The Middleburg course was inspected on April 11, 2011 by Doug Fout.

Turf - The turf is in good shape and is growing steadily.

Smoothness - The course has been aerated and rolled.

Compaction - Soft. The course was very soft underfoot.

Moisture - There is plenty of moisture in ground.

Notes - The course will be mowed Friday, April 15. We had 2-1/2 inches of rain April 7-8, and more rain is expected on Friday, April 15.
