There will be NO through traffic on Tufton Avenue after 2 PM.
 General Parking must enter from the East via Falls Road/I-83. All Patron and Subscriber pass holders must access their lots from the West/Greenspring Avenue side. At 3:30 PM the police will close all entrances to the course and Tufton Avenue.

There will be a mandatory Riders meeting with the Stewards at the paddock at 3:40 PM.

NSA hang tags will admit cars to General Admission lot only.

As a convenience to Riders, the Stewards Advisory Committee has instructed the Clerks of Scales to account for a 2 lb allowance for the safety vest upon weighing out. Therefore, all Riders must weigh out at 2 lbs. over their assigned weight, with their safety vest.

Attention Horsemen:

Horsemen must call J.W.Y. Martin Jr. 410-833-1167 by noon, Friday, April 29, 2011 to request stalls.

Starting at 2 pm, there will be a shuttle for Riders between the paddock and the Worthington Farms barn.

All entries must be at Worthington Farms barns and checked in with NSA Steward Representative, Joe Clancy Sr. by 1:30 PM and remain until paddock call.

In keeping with the 115-year tradition of no commercial activity at our meet, the Maryland Hunt Cup will not permit any type of advertising on a Rider or a horse running in this race.

All scratches must be made no later than forty-five (45) minutes prior to post time for the Maryland Hunt Cup. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

Mr. & Mrs. JWY Martin Jr. invite all participants and officials to view the race video at Snow Hill following the running of the race.

Fines will be imposed.

No dogs will be permitted on the Maryland Hunt Cup course on race day, nor will they be permitted in the stabling area at Worthington Farms. Please leave your dogs at home.

Mandatory veterinary examination for all entries at 2:00 PM at the Worthington Farms barns. NO BANDAGES of any kind will be permitted for this exam.

Special Notes:

The Paddock configuration and policies have changed. There will be two sections of the Paddock:

- 1) Horsemen Section - only Participating Horsemen and certain Officials will be allowed in this section. Wristbands will be provided to Participating Horsemen and those Officials.
- 2) Subscriber Section - holders of Paddock tickets, current NSA credentials and Press passes will be allowed in this section.

The Rider changing area will be on the West side of the Subscriber section of the Paddock.

After all Riders are mounted, the post parade will proceed from the Paddock / finish line, up the stretch and towards the last fence. There will be a gap prior to the last fence to exit the stretch.

The Maryland Hunt Cup course was inspected by Race Secretary Sherlock Gillet Jr, on April 24, 2011.

This course is run over "Fair Hunting Country."

Turf: The areas of the course that are pastures were seeded in September. The grass is coming up well. The Turf varies throughout the course, but is generally good to very good.

Smoothness: No horses on the course since March 24. Course has been aerated, culti-packed and is quite nice.

Compaction: Lange Penetrometer readings ranged from 6-10 depending on elevation

Moisture Meter: 9-10; The course received rain on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
