There will be an officials meeting at 1:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand. Officials are to enter Gate 5 off Route 52 and must display their NSA hangtag or their Winterthur issued hangtag. If you do not have proper credentials, you must call Jill Abbott prior to race day at 302.218.7529.

Attention Riders: There will be a mandatory jockeys meeting with the Stewards 45 minutes prior to the first race.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam performed by Dr. Charles C. M. Arensberg, VMD.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes is to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

There will be no temporary stabling, horses will run off the vans.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE VAN AREA BEFORE EVERY RACE AND PROCEED TO THE PADDOCK AS A GROUP. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Credentials Needed: NSA Horsemen lapel pins and NSA Hangtag mandatory. MUST ENTER OFF RT.52/KENNETT PIKE at GATE 5 with NSA hangtag visible on rearview mirror.

Please check alternative routes to Rt. 52. Please note the new event staggered opening for guests. Gates open at 11:30 for General Admission, this may cause delays. We recommend arriving prior to 11:30 because of potential for increased traffic due to gates opening later than in previous years. This change was made in conjunction with the Delaware State Police. Please note this change, and adjust your departure accordingly.

The Winterthur course was inspected Saturday, April 23, 2011 by Clerk of Course, Rob Plankinton.

**Turf:** The turf on this course consists of a relatively thick, lush cover of native fescue and "Division One", a mixture of turf fescues, blues, and rye grass that averaged 6" in height and is consistent.

**Smoothness:** This course has been rolled and the ground is relatively smooth throughout.

**Compaction:** 102 (Good). Grass cover provides good cushion.

**Moisture:** 7.8 (average wet)

**Notes:** Eight traditional "stake and bound" timber fences with telephone pole ground base rails serve as the timber course. The first fence is five panels wide and the remaining seven fences are four panels wide. At least two of the fences offer only one option for "run around room". However, this concern has not caused any problems in the past.

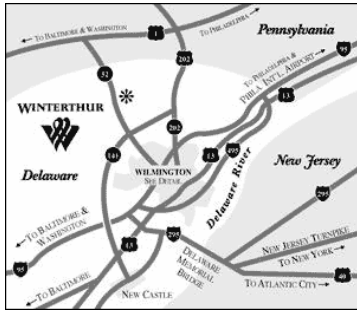

**If traveling over the Commodore Barry Bridge:**

- Take 95 South to Wilmington; take exit 7B, which is Delaware Avenue/Rte. 52
- At end of exit ramp, turn right at light to head NW out of town
- As soon as possible, move into left-most lane because road splits; stay on Rte. 52 North
- Winterthur is on Rte. 52, six miles NW of Wilmington

**If traveling over the Delaware Memorial Bridge:**

- After crossing Delaware Memorial Bridge, follow 95 North to Wilmington
- Take exit 7, which is Delaware Avenue/Rte. 52
- Travel three blocks to Rte. 52; take a left at light
- Stay in left-most lane to stay on Rte. 52 North
- Winterthur is on Rte. 52, six miles NW of Wilmington

**From I-476 (the Blue Route):**

- Take the Blue Route to I-95 South to Wilmington
- Follow directions from Philadelphia.

**From Baltimore/Washington:**

- Take 95 North to Wilmington; take exit 7, which is Delaware Avenue/Rte. 52
