Manager for a stall assignment before putting horses into stalls.

There will be food for all participating horsemen at the Paddock
Pavilion.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report
horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be
made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.
Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes
are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE
REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE
IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Waste Disposal: There will be a bio-waste disposal container in the
horse barn for disposal of any needles, syringes etc. Please do not
dispose of these materials in any other trash container.

Credentials Needed: Owners, trainers and riders participating on
race day will receive passes from Willowdale Steeplechase for
Gate 3. All other horsemen and NSA members must park in NSA
Parking (Gate 2). Show NSA horsemen pins, Patron pins, or
membership cards for admission to enter the grounds. Lauren
Mendenhall and Shannon Campbell are barn Managers. Any
horseman or official passes not received in the mail prior to the
races will be handed out at the horseman's gate which is Gate 3.
