All horses must have a current coggins and health certificate as every horse will be checked on entry to the Kentucky Horse Park.

There will be a vet check for all horses at 10 a.m. next to stabling area.

Paddock information: All horses will be saddled at the barn and proceed to paddock together in numerical order as per stable steward.

**Turf:** Turf is in good shape although slightly hampered by drought and the World Equestrian Games.

**Smoothness:** Good, two areas are muddy from rain but should be good by race day.

**Compaction:** 90.5 (Good) Due to have more rain this week.

**Moisture:** 7 (Average Wet)
