Strawberry Hill Races will be conducting pari-mutuel wagering and,  
therefore, all participants must be licensed by the Virginia Racing  
Commission (VRC Info: 804-966-7412). PLEASE NOTE: ALL VRC  
LICENSES EXPIRED ON DECEMBER 31, 2010. Therefore, everyone will  
need to file for a 2011 license. Owner, Trainer, and Jockey licenses  
are \$50 each. If fingerprint processing is required the fee is \$40.  
CHECK OR CASH IS THE ONLY ACCEPTIBLE FORM OF PAYMENT (NO  
CREDIT CARDS). The VRC Office will be open at 8:00 a.m., Saturday,  
May 21 and the office is located on the backside of the track. Please

and downloadable forms.

Colonial Downs will also offer simulcast wagering on site on a  
number of tracks including Pimlico on Saturday, May 21, culminating  
with the Preakness Stakes (6:19 p.m.). Strawberry Hill will alternate  
the video feed from Pimlico with their own live races as feasible over  
the video monitors throughout the facility. Post time for the First

**ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED IN THE PADDOCK.**

EARLY ARRIVAL IS ENCOURAGED. HEAVY TRAFFIC IS EXPECTED ON ALL INTERSTATES. This date later in the season may contribute to added traffic on I-64 headed to Virginia's coastal areas so horsemen are encouraged to plan their arrival accordingly. Horsemen are advised to access Colonial Downs via I-64 (although general public are being directed to Route 60). Police will be working to expedite horses and facilitate their entry into Colonial Downs.

Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

The use of raised toes is prohibited. A "raised" toe is defined as an extension of the toe that exceeds 1/16 inch in depth.

The course was inspected on May 6, 2011 by Sue Mullins, Race Director, and J. D. Thomas, Colonial Downs Turf Superintendent.

**Turf:** Bermuda grass developing thick growth and very green indicating well out of dormancy. Thick cover and very springy consistency. Inconsequential isolated broadleaf weeds. Uniform height through overall course.

**Smoothness:** Course is very smooth and regular throughout with appropriate banking in turns.

**Compaction:** Average 96.94 (Good) at measurements taken at 18 locations around the course

**Moisture:** Average 5.5 (Average) at measurements taken at 18 locations around the course.
