IMPORTANT NOTICE: All vans and owners-trainers-riders MUST come in the following route: I-20 to Exit 22/US-1 towards Aiken. Travel 5 miles. Turn left at 118/78 towards Williston. Travel 4 miles. This highway turns into Pine Log Road. Turn Right on Powderhouse Road. Horsemen's gate will be on the left.

Stabling: Shavings will be provided for bedding.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.
