Owners, trainers and riders are reminded to have their NSA Horsemen's Pin and/or NYRA badge for admission. NYRA no longer permits will calls.

Shoe Rule: Queen's Plate or Queen's Plate XT only.

NEW YORK STATE RACING COMMISSION RULES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF LASIX.

All jump riders must ride in a helmet approved by the NSA at Saratoga and use a ProCush Whip. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES.

Note: The Belmont Park course will be set up with 6 flights of National Fence (3 down the back side and 3 on the front side) and the 2-1/4 mile race will be run over 11 hurdles.

Runners Reward applies, with all fees waived for any horses which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.

All owners and trainers are required to pay an assessment to the New York Injured Jockey Compensation Fund. The charge is \$198 per start for the first four starts, for a maximum of \$792 per year, plus .90% of all earned purse money. In addition, New York State statutory fees of 1% for the backstretch pension fund plus 2% to NYTHA will be deducted from any purse earnings at Belmont. There is a \$20 lasix fee for all horses that are administered lasix and a \$10 start fee to be paid to the New York State Racing and Wagering Board for all horses that run.
