There will be a pre-race veterinary exam. All bandages must be removed.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

Attention Jockeys: All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 12:15 p.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND

Attention Horsemen: Georgia state law requires that a valid health certificate and negative coggins test accompany a horse being transported in the State of Georgia.

NSA Shoe Policy

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Block heels are permitted, however the toe may not exceed 1/16 of an inch.

The video images will be provided by HCP Sports, headed by Sam Slater, and will be sent by satellite uplink to the United States Equestrian Federation to be streamed immediately on the USEF Network website.
