THE COLONIAL CUP COMMITTEE IS CONCERNED ABOUT DAYLIGHT AND THE RACES WILL RUN EVERY 40 MINUTES. THE COMMITTEE AND OFFICIALS ARE LOOKING FOR FULL COOPERATION FROM HORSEMEN TO HAVE THEIR HORSES IN THE PADDOCK IN A TIMELY MANNER (20 MINUTES PRIOR TO POST TIME). THE STEWARDS WILL BE MONITORING THE SITUATION CLOSELY. POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE IS 12:30 P.M. WITH PADDOCK TIME OF 12:05 P.M.

All post race testing will be done in two stalls of the four stall barn between Barn B (Sheppard) and the Block Barn. The designated stalls face the Block Barn. Please be advised that horsemen will need to make necessary arrangements for buckets and equipment to cool their horses out in this area if being tested. No horse will be allowed to go back to any other barns: A, C, D, E until completion of testing.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 11:35 a.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

Attention Horsemen: There will be no schooling or training on the racecourse or around the outside of the racecourse. The committee thanks all horsemen for their cooperation. Please adhere to all training signs posted at the gaps going to the schooling field.

#### NSA Shoe Policy

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Block heels are permitted, however the toe may not exceed 1/16 of an inch.

Please pick up race credentials prior to 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 19. Stable Gate between #1 and Barn C will be open for easy access and there will be a Horsemen's Gate off of Springdale Drive between Gate #6 and Gate #2 opens at 9:00 a.m.

All horsemen attending the Colonial Cup are invited to a complimentary lunch at the NEW Horsemen's Luncheon Tent behind the Jockey's Room. Participating horsemen will receive two complimentary credentials, two Lexus luncheon tent wristbands, and one parking credential in an envelope. The course was inspected on November 7, 2011 by Clerk of Course, Jeff Teter.

**Turf:** The turf consists of dormant Bermuda grass that was finish mowed to 4 inches in height. The course was drill seeded with wheat at the end of September. The wheat has been mowed once. The race course was aerated and rolled in the summer and aerated again the beginning of September.

**Smoothness:** The race course is smooth throughout.

**Compaction:** The compaction meter read from 80 to 130 throughout, averaging 90 to 110 in compaction (Good).

**Moisture:** Moisture reading is dry. We had just over 3 inches of rain in October and about 7/10 of an inch last week. They are calling for rain on Thursday, November 10. The ground does have some moisture in it.

**Notes:** The Colonial Cup will be run over National Fences, and all hurdle races will run over a variation of the Colonial Cup course. The former "black plastic" hurdle course will not be in use.
