COGGINS TEST, HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND INOCULATIONS

Coggins Test - All horses (including ponies) must have a current negative Coggins test dated within the twelve (12) months and which is valid for the duration of the meet. Furthermore, the Coggins test must be attached to the horse Jockey Club certificate when placed on file in the horse identifiers office.

Health Certificate - A valid health certificate dated within 10 days (subject to change due to circumstances) with proof of EHV vaccination (between 7-90 days) is required to enter Colonial Downs Stable Area.

Attention Riders: Please contact Colonial Downs to confirm what time you must be in the Jock's Room. Rider allowances must be claimed at the time of entry. All jump riders must ride in a helmet approved by the NSA and use a ProCush Whip. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES.

The races at Colonial Downs are run under the rules and sanction of the Virginia Racing Commission (VRC). All owners, trainers and riders must be licensed by the VRC. All applicants, excluding owners, must have status to work in the United States, and therefore must be a U.S. citizen, a current permanent resident alien or possess a currently active work permit. Prior to any horse racing in Virginia the owner/owners and trainer must provide a completed application and full payment to the VRC; after which, a thirty day allowance will be granted to complete the fingerprint process. All purses will be held until the process is complete.

A Workmen's Compensation policy for all trainers must be on file with the VRC. Virginia Racing Commission can be reached at (804) 966-7400 or www.vrc.virginia.gov.

ATTENTION TRAINERS: If you are not able to saddle your horse, you must have a licensed trainer or assistant and inform the Paddock Judge as to who will saddle the horse. Failure to do so will be subject to a fine. ALL HORSES RUNNING AT COLONIAL DOWNS MUST BE TATTOOED AND BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME OF THEIR RACE. FOAL PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY THE HORSE. Trainers are responsible for all information on their horses foal papers. THIS INCLUDES SEX AND OWNER OF THE HORSE. All horses must run in the name(s) of the owner(s) listed on the foal papers. Incorrect ownership is a Class 4 felony in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Reminder Horsemen: Riders are FINAL at the draw. If you do not have a call, please name a backup. Stewards reserve the right to name a rider at the time of the draw.

SHOE RULE - Front shoes which have a toe grab greater than 2 millimeters shall be prohibited for racing or training on all racing surfaces at Colonial Downs. This includes but is not limited to the following: toe grabs, bends, jar calks, stickers or any other traction device worn on the front shoes of thoroughbred horses. Hind shoes with calks, stickers, blocks, raised toes or turndowns will not be allowed on the turf course. This includes quarter horse shoes or any shoe with a toe grab of more than one-quarter inch.

Trainers must go to their assigned stall(s) no less than 4 hrs. prior to post. Also, the trainer shall have a representative available to assist

the VRC veterinarian with the pre-race exam. If there is a problem with your stall please contact the racing department. If you wish to ship in to another trainer's barn you must obtain permission from the stall superintendent. Those who choose to ignore this request shall be sent to the stewards.

The steeplechase races will be started by NSA Starter, Barry Watson.

Purses for these races will be distributed by the NSA Central Bookkeeping Office as follows: 60% to the winner; 18% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 4% to fifth; 3% to sixth. The NSA will deduct an administrative fee equivalent to 2% of the purse from owners whose horses earn a portion of the purse. Runners Reward applies, with all fees waived for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.

Note: The Colonial Downs course will be set up with 5 flights of National Fence (3 down the back side and 2 on the front side) and the 2-1/4 mile races will be run over 10 hurdles.
