All races at Fair Hill are run under the jurisdiction of the Maryland Racing Commission. Owners, trainers and riders must be licensed by the Maryland Racing Commission. All trainers must be covered by workmen's compensation insurance and a certificate of insurance evidencing that coverage must be presented prior to starting. In order to alleviate congestion in the racing office at the Fair Hill Races, you may obtain the license form from the NSA office. Any questions regarding licensing or insurance should contact the MRC licensing office at 410-296-9682.

**All foreign jockeys must have current visa and proper proof of eligibility to work in the USA or they will not be allowed to ride.**

There will be a meeting of all officials in the paddock at 12:00 p.m.

There will be a mandatory jockey's meeting in the paddock at 12:15 p.m. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

The use of Phenylbutazone and Lasix will be permitted, according to Maryland rules. Adjunct medication is permissible if declared before 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 25. All race day medication must be administered by a veterinarian licensed by the Maryland Racing Commission. A certificate from the administering vet stating when and how much Lasix was administered must be turned in to Dr. Peacock at the Fair Hill Races.

No scratches after scratch time, Wednesday, unless excused by the Stewards.

**Attention Trainers:** Foal certificates and current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test must be on file at the races.

Rider allowances ("bugs") must be claimed no later than 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 25.

Maryland Million Premium Bonuses will be awarded to Maryland Million nominated horses that compete in the Maiden Claiming Hurdle, Maiden Hurdle, the Filly & Mare Hurdle Stakes, Conditioned Claiming Hurdle and the Novice Timber. A \$5,000 bonus applies in each race and bonus money will be distributed as follows: 60% to the winner, 30% to second and 10% to third.

Drs. Kathy Anderson and Charles Arensberg will be providing vet services.

O/T/R parking will be permitted in the BLUE parking area only off of Route 273. There will be absolutely no parking behind the NSA office.

There will be an O/T/R hospitality area in the paddock. NSA credentials will be honored.

The Fair Hill racecourse was inspected by NSA Safety Advisor Barry Watson on Monday, May 16, 2011.

**Main Course:** The overall condition of Fair Hill as improved significantly. The condition of the grass cover has improved again this year as a result of steady maintenance and good solid equipment. However, there are a couple of issues that are noteworthy to report. There is evidence of training traffic on the flat course that has left this area fractionally uneven, however there was also more recent use by two horses in the #2 and #4 paths that has left a deeper depression than the rest of the course. The hurdle course was found to be in relatively good shape throughout.

**Turf:** The course consisted of a relatively thick, lush cover of fescue that averaged four inches in height at the time of inspection. Smoothness: The flat course had a fractionally uneven feel throughout, particularly in the #1 and #2 paths. The hurdle course was relatively smooth throughout.

**Compaction:** 80-90(Good). These readings represent the most favorable conditions in recent memory.

**Moisture:** 8-9 (Average Wet).

**Timber Course:** The timber fences on this course have been recently refurbished. The third fence will remain a stake and bound construction, while the fifth (last) and the sixth will be a variation of the post and rail design. All the fences on this course have a very clean, tidy look. There were a number of noteworthy issues to report. There is some old divot damage from the 6th fence to the 9th fence caused by a large, heavy horse moving in the opposite direction along the inside panels from the 9th to the 6th. Many of these divots will not come into play, but there is a number of them in the running lanes between the 8th and 9th that will. A couple more of the same type divot can be found on this course. The first is in the #2 panel running lane, halfway between 9th and 10th. The other can be found on the inside of the approach to the 4th, about 100 yards before the fence. There were few areas of scaring to report. The first is 15 feet from the base of the landing side of the 2nd. The second is in the middle part, of the apex of the turn between the 2nd and 3rd. The third and fourth of these areas are between the 3rd and 4th fences. Most of the third area (tire marks) should not come into play. However, the fourth area, (tire marks) 100 yards past the 3rd could be more of an issue. There was a large groundhog hole in the base of the landing side of the 1st fence of the timber course. There is some old concrete drainage tile in the base of the 8th that should not be cause for concern. There is a drainage hole in the base of the landing side of the same fence. There was an area of ground under repair to the left of the running lane approaching the 5th (last) fence that should not come into play.

**Note:** Most of these areas of concern are typical to most courses, routinely noted and repaired by the Clerk of the Course.

**DIRECTIONS:** The Fair Hill Races are located in Cecil County, Maryland, just 10 minutes off I-95, midway between Philadelphia, PA and Baltimore, MD.

**DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH:** I-95 South or the New Jersey Turnpike South into Delaware. Continue on I-95 through toll booth into Maryland. Take the first Maryland exit, Route 279 South to Elkton, not Newark, DE. Follow to 3rd Traffic Light. Turn Right on Route 213 North. Go approximately 8 miles to 1st Traffic Light (Junction of Route 213 and Route 273). Turn right onto Route 273. Entrance to Fair Hill Races will be on the right, with additional parking across the street.

**DIRECTIONS FROM THE SOUTH:** I-95 North from Baltimore. After paying the toll at the Susquehanna River Toll Booth, go approximately 7 miles to the Exit 100 (Route 272 North East/Rising Sun). Follow Route 272 North about 5 miles to the traffic light at the intersection of Route 273. Turn right onto Route 273 East toward Newark, DE. Go 5 miles to the traffic light at the intersection of Routes 273 and 213. The entrance to Fair Hill Races is just past the traffic light.

**DIRECTIONS FROM NEWARK, DE:** Route 273 West approximately 5 miles to Fair Hill Races.
