Attention Jockeys: All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 12:00 p.m. in the Jock's Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND. JOCKEYS MAY NOT WEAR ADVERTISING ON THEIR BRITCHES.

All horses must be on the grounds no later than 10:00 a.m. for vet check. Post Time for the First Race is 1:00 p.m.

ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED AT THE BARN, ASSEMBLE IN NUMERIC ORDER IN THE BARN PADDOCK PRIOR TO EACH RACE AND PROCEED TO THE TOWER PADDOCK AS A GROUP. TRAINERS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHEDULE THAT WILL BE POSTED IN THE BARN AREA.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

NSA Shoe Policy

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted.

All vans arriving Friday, Oct. 21 must use Gate 2 off Route 202. Security will continuously check Gate for late arrivals.

Current NSA credentials will be honored for admission to the racecourse grounds. Horsemen will be issued paddock passes upon request to Patti Tegenborg via email (ptegenborg@farhillsrace.org) or telephone (908-234-9115).

Stabling: Bedding will be provided to horses on racecourse free of charge upon application to Natalie Gallagher (973) 539-7679. Racecourse phone will be manned: (908) 234-9115.

After the last race there will be a reception for all owners, trainers, riders, officials and their guests in the tent at the top of the hill in the grove.

Live streaming video available for Far Hills

The National Steeplechase Association, in conjunction with the United States Equestrian Federation, will offer live streaming video broadcasts of Far Hills on a pay-per-view basis.

The pay-per-view charge will be \$29.95 and the video can be accessed from either the National Steeplechase Association website, www.nationalsteeplechase.com, or through the USEF Network at www.usefnetwork.com. The video images will be provided by HCP Sports, headed by Sam Slater, and will be sent by satellite uplink to the United States Equestrian Federation to be streamed immediately on the USEF Network website.

The course was inspected on October 10, 2011 by Clerk of Course, Dean Torsilieri.

Turf: The entire turf course at Moorland Farm was aerated, slice seeded, and sand top dressed immediately after the Far Hills fall 2010 meet. Spring 2011 operations included divot repair, fertilization, rolling and aeration. The entire turf received supplemental irrigation as needed throughout the growing season to maintain balanced moisture levels in the upper 10" soil profile. Weekly application rates and frequency were adjusted to insure one inch of water, applied either through rainfall or the irrigation system during May and June. No supplemental irrigation was required past June 18, 2011 due to local conditions. Weekly mowing, weed control, and an aggressive IPM program have continued to keep the quality and consistency of the turf at the highest possible level. The turf is thick, lush, and has a clipped top-out height of 6-8". There are few bare or thin areas on any parts of the timber or hurdle courses. There are small areas of damage due to standing water throughout the summer; however, these areas are mostly on the outside fence line adjacent to the patrol judge pathway.

Smoothness: The course has been rolled, aerated, and hand walked with root zone mix to fill any divots or cupping. The surface is smooth and consistent with a giving, yet firm resiliency. There is NO vehicular traffic allowed on the course at any time.

Compaction: 75-85 (Yielding to Good)

Moisture: 6-7 (Average to Average Wet)

Notes: The weather over the last weekend has been tremendous in drying the turf course and surrounding fields at Moorland Farm. We expect conditions to continue to improve through out the next 12 days.

Directions:

From Route 78: Take Exit 29 to Route 287 North to Exit 22B (Route 202/206 North). Bear right at Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From Bernardsville via Route 202 South: At railroad tracks in Far Hills, turn left onto Liberty Corner Road (county #512) to Gate #4 or Gate #5.

From the South via Route 287: Take Exit 22B. Turn right onto Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.

From the North via Route 287: Take Exit 22 to Route 202/206 North. Bear right onto Route 202 North and proceed to Gate #2.
