Attention Trainers: There will be 50 stalls available at Foxfield on a first come/first serve basis.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary examination in the stable area beginning at 10:30 a.m.

Brian and Kay Barquin will issue horseman's credentials at the barn.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes is to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Attention Jockeys: All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys

Meeting at 12:45 p.m. at the Jockey's Tent. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

Horsemen: All owners, trainers, and riders should enter through the East gate (closest gate to Charlottesville). Following the races all traffic will exit eastward from the East Gate. Garth Road will be closed to through traffic. Horsemen's credentials will be held at the East Gate. Please pick them up at the "Will Call".

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months." The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds. This requirement will be strictly enforced.

The Foxfield course was inspected on September 13, 2011 by Patrick Butterfield.

Turf: The turf is presently at 8 inches. It will be trimmed today to a height of 5 inches and not mowed again.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 100 - Average

Moisture: Wet - last rained night of September 12.

Notes: We have had lots of rain recently. The course is in excellent condition.

Directions:

From the North (Washington D.C.): Take Route 29 South to 250 By-Pass West exit (Lynchburg). Get off at 1st exit (Barracks Road – Rt. 654), turn right and Foxfield is 4 miles on the left.

From the South (Lynchburg): Take Route 29 North to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the East (Richmond): Take I-64 West to Shadwell (Exit 124), turn right and go 4.7 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn right, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

From the West (Waynesboro): Take I-64 East to 29 North (Exit 118-B), go 3.2 miles to Barracks Road exit (Rt. 654), turn left, Foxfield is 4 miles on left.

Avoiding Barracks Road traffic: Traveling 29 South from the Warrenton/Culpepper area, approximately 10 miles north of Charlottesville look for signs to the Charlottesville/Albemarle Airport. There is a traffic light and a car dealership called Airport Auto. This is Route 649, turn right. Go 7/10 of a mile and bear left at the airport. Go 1 mile to intersection at end of runway and bear left to stop sign. This is Route 743, turn left. Go 3 miles to bridge. Cross bridge and turn right onto Route 676 (watch for bad curves). Go 4.2 miles to end of road and turn left onto Route 601. Go 9/10 of a mile to end of road at the store and turn left. Foxfield will be on the right. Follow traffic officers and signs to East Gate.
