Attention Horsemen: NSA car passes will allow for admission to the grounds by way of the Horseman's Gate #2. NSA horsemen pins allow horsemen access to the paddock and on Members Hill and the horsemen's hospitality tent. There will be a stable hospitality tent located in the stable area with beverages and food for grooms and horsemen that cannot leave the stable.

**Live streaming video available for four NSA fall race meets**

The National Steeplechase Association, in conjunction with the United States Equestrian Federation, will offer live streaming video broadcasts of four fall-championship race meets on a pay-per-view basis. The live video streaming begins with the International Gold Cup on Saturday, Oct. 15, and continues with the Far Hills Races on Oct. 22, the Steeplechase at Callaway Gardens on Nov. 5, and the Marion duPont Scott Colonial Cup on Nov. 19.

The pay-per-view charge will be \$29.95 for each race meet, and the video can be accessed from either the National Steeplechase Association website, [www.nationalsteeplechase.com](http://www.nationalsteeplechase.com), or through the USEF Network at [www.usefnetwork.com](http://www.usefnetwork.com). The video images will be provided by HCP Sports, headed by Sam Slater, and will be sent by satellite uplink to the United States Equestrian Federation to be streamed immediately on the USEF Network website.

No schooling on the racecourse due to course preparation. The course will be set and flagged by Thursday evening.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

Stalls will be provided - Depending on the number of horses entered, there may be no additional stalls for ponies. Special requests/arrangements, contact Larry Smith (540) 822-9305.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinary examination from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for all entries. Bandages must be removed.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months." The certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds.

Horsemen's Enclosure Tent (adjacent to the Steward Stand) please come enjoy the official and horsemen's luncheon from 11:30 am until 2:00 pm. Horsemen are invited to the After Race Party at the Horsemen's Enclosure Tent following the last race.

Stable Hospitality Tent (East side of the Stable Tent) coffee, drinks, snacks and light fare will be provided all day for horsemen.

**Notes:** Two strong weed kills had a fertilizer spreading over the past months combined with all of the rain have made the course "Beautiful".

### Directions for the Horsemen's Gate:

From Washington: Take I-66 West to Exit 43A onto Rt. 29 South for approximately 11 miles toward Warrenton. Take exit for Rt. 17 North toward Winchester for 8 miles to Old Tavern Road (also Rt. 245) on right. Do not join right hand lane on Rt. 17 waiting to enter Gate 8.

From Middleburg: West on Rt. 50 from Middleburg, then South on Zulla Road (also Rt. 709), then left on Rt. 17 South and left on Old Tavern Road (Rt. 245).

From Warrenton and South: North on Rt. 17, then right on Old Tavern Road (Rt. 245). Proceed directly to Rt. 245, do not join in the right hand lane waiting to enter Gate 8 on Rt. 17.

From Leesburg: Take Rt. 15 South to I-66 West at Haymarket; take Exit 28 to Rt. 17 South, turn left on Rt. 845 (Old Winchester Road).
