Trainers who would like to ship to the grounds on Friday in an effort to avoid traffic delays need to call ahead to Martha Strawther at the Montpelier office 540-672-0027. The gates to Montpelier will be locked unless previous arrangements have been made.

Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier.

The Virginia Department of Agriculture is requiring that all horses be accompanied by a negative Coggins conducted within the last 12 months and a valid Health Certificate for those coming out of state in order to gain access to the grounds of any meet run in Virginia.

All owners, trainers and riders with NSA credentials running horses at the Montpelier races this year are asked to check in at the entrance to the hospitality area within the paddock to receive their hospitality tickets for the day.

All horses are required to be on the grounds for a vet check beginning at 10 a.m. Saturday at the barn. Horses may be checked in at the barn area between 9 a.m.- 11:30 a.m.

WE PREFER THAT HORSES ASSEMBLE IN THE BARN AREA AND PROCEED TO THE PADDOCK IN SMALL GROUPS. Trainers have the option to saddle in the barn or Paddock (two new saddling stalls with high sides have been constructed in the Paddock).

NOTE TO HORSEMEN -- VERY IMPORTANT - new entrance to Montpelier for Horse Vans and Trailers ONLY which should eliminate having to deal with traffic for General Parking and pedestrians. New Directions: From Orange and North: travel PAST the old entrance (Dolly Madison Road) and PAST the main entrance to Montpelier to the next road on the left, Route 639, Jacksontown Road, go left. Follow just 3 / 10 of mile to Y in road and bear left, watch for TAGG'S ISLAND ROAD sign on left and enter at marked entrance, will be manned. This entrance is for HORSE vans ONLY. Follow good gravel road past flat track stop to sign at Center Road, cross Center Road, (will have traffic director there) and take next left into race barn.

From Charlottesville and South: You will come to Rt. 639 before other entrances to Montpelier, go right and follow directions above. (Brian Hogan recently drove this road and proclaimed it a good idea)

ALSO - FOR NSA MEMBERS. Please stop at the ticket takers at the entrances and get an INFIELD Parking Pass. This is complimentary but necessary to park in the Infield. If you do not stop you will be stopped inside. Those NSA members running horses may park at the Barn.

Scratches/Results Hotline

The NSA Hotline for scratches and results can be accessed by calling (859) 288-1066. Scratches will be posted by 2 p.m. Wednesday, with results usually posted by 7:00 p.m. the day of the race.

The Montpelier course was inspected by Ed Harvey on October 23, 2011.

Turf: Thick and lush. Very long, it will be mowed before race day but due to the rain and then ideal conditions it is growing fast. We anticipate it will be 6-7 inches long for the races.

Smoothness: Uniform, no smoothness problems detected except as noted below.

Compaction: 80-100 (Yielding to Good) The course was tested in very close increments. There were a couple of places where it scored 50 or 60 (Yielding) in the lower areas which had dried out significantly three days before the inspection, and we anticipate they will be more compact on race day.

Moisture: 4-6 (Average Dry to Average) A few areas tested 3-4 (Average Dry) and a couple at 8 (Average Wet). In general it is wet, not slippery, and the low areas are holding up with the exception listed below. With the few more dry days forecast the course will be able to absorb more rain without detriment if it rains before race day

Notes: One area near the historic "water jump" on the far side of the course from the finish line is very wet for a short stretch near the rail. This will be closely monitored and will be cordoned off if need be on race day.

Directions:

From Washington, D.C. – West on I-66 to US 29 South to third Culpeper Exit. South on Route 15 to Orange, VA, or take I-95 to Fredericksburg; west on Route 3 to Route 20 South to Orange. From downtown Orange take Route 20 W to Montpelier.

From Richmond – West on I-64 to Route 15 North to Orange, VA. From downtown Orange take Route 20 South to Montpelier Station.

From Charlottesville – East on Route 20 to Montpelier Station, or US 29 North to State Route 33 East to Route 20 East to Montpelier Station.

At Montpelier Station - Horse Vans enter West Gate (furthest from Orange) Route 639 follow signs to new gravel road that runs on the back of the property, crosses Center Road to left turn to Barn. Will be marked with signs. Others follow directions on parking pass. Please park in Officials (Red) area or VIP (Orange) area. Parking in undesignated areas may result in towing.
