These Races will be started by NSA Starter, Barry Watson.

The races at Philadelphia Park are run under the rules and sanction of the Pennsylvania Racing Commission. All owners, trainers, and riders must be licensed by the Pennsylvania Racing Commission. Workers' Comp. policy for all trainers must be on file with the Pennsylvania Racing Commission.

Attention Horsemen: If you hold a track license in the following jurisdictions, please bring it with you to avoid being charged for fingerprinting: Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, and Virginia.

The overpass on Galloway Rd. between the stable gate and Richlieu Rd. is closed, use Mechanicsville Rd. to reach the stable gate.

All steeplechase jockeys must report with the Clerk of Scales. All Jockeys must have a current physical card (within one year) or see the physician at Philadelphia Park prior to riding. Also, all riders who are not U.S. citizens must have proper immigration documents. All jockeys must use the ProCush Whip.

SHOE RULE - Queens Plates only for turf racing.

A negative coggins test is required for each calendar year.

All horses and ponies shipping to Philadelphia Park from outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania are required to have health certificates issued within a 7-day period immediately preceding the date of arrival.

*** ATTENTION HORSEMEN ***

As a reminder, it is your responsibility to ensure that only your stable employees with a current PA State Horse Racing Commission license are allowed into the State Detention Barn with your horse for post race testing. A day pass issued by security is NOT accepted as a license.

FIROCOXIB, a NSAID is being detected by PETRL in race samples and this medication should NOT be found in a racing sample. Beting February 14, 2011 any sample found to contain FIROCOXIB will be deemed a positive test. The Pennsylvania State Horse Racing Commission announced November 18, 2010 that ANY CAPSAICIN found in any samples will be considered a positive test.

Any device that restricts the vision of a horse from beside or behind other than traditional hooded blinkers will NOT be allowed to be worn in a race.

The PA Racing Commission has issued revised policies on Phenylbutazone and DMSO effective Sept. 15, 2010. Please contact the Commission Vet Office (ext 3307) or PTHA Office (ext 3322) for further details.

Horsemen should make sure that their horses are updated on their West Nile Vaccinations since there have been two diagnosed cases recently in PA.

Purse Distribution - Purses will be distributed by the NSA as follows: 60% to the winner; 18% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 4% to fifth; and 3% to sixth. Any Pennsylvania Breeders bonus money will be paid out by the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association.

Fees - An administrative fee equivalent to 2% of the purse will be retained by the NSA from owners whose horses earn a portion of the purse. "Runners reward" applies, with all fees waived, for any horse which runs and does not earn a portion of the purse.
