Attention Horsemen: Trainers are NO LONGER required to report horses on the grounds, if they are running. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race. Foal papers and any other material for horse identification purposes are to be turned in to the Horse Identifier. TRAINERS ARE REMINDED TO PICK UP FOAL PAPERS FROM THE HORSE IDENTIFIER FOR HORSES RUNNING IN CLAIMING RACES.

Attention Jockeys: All jockeys are reminded to check-in with the Clerk of Scales one hour prior to post time of the first race and report his/her engagement(s) and overweight, if any. There will be a Jockeys Meeting at 1:15 p.m. in the Jock's Room. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND.

A pre-race veterinary exam is required of each entry beginning at 12:00 noon in the barn area. Bandages are not permitted during the examination.

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race.

The Virginia Department of Agriculture will send a State Inspector to examine current coggins (EIA) within one calendar year. They MAY or MAY NOT allow horses on the grounds without a negative coggins.

The course was inspected on September 15, 2011 by Doug Fout.

**Turf:** Tall fescue, good cover on the entire course.

**Smoothness:** The course has been aerated, rolled and chain harrowed. There is one spot going down the hill by the pond that has a few divots which will be filled in and rolled next week.

**Compaction:** 55 (Yielding)

**Moisture:** 8 (Average Wet)

**Notes:** We had one inch of rain on September 14 and 5.5 inches the previous week. The course will be mowed to 6 inches one week out from the race date.
