The **Three-Year-Old Champion** will be the horse, three years old, which earns the most points.

The **Claimer of the Year** will be the horse that earns the most money in claiming races.

The **Timber Champion** will be the horse which earns the most money racing over timber.

The **Champion Timber Owner** will be the owner whose horses earn the most money racing over timber.

The **Champion Timber Trainer** will be the trainer who wins the most races over timber.

The **Champion Timber Jockey** will be the jockey who wins the most races over timber.
