ATTENTION HORSEMEN: Any horses that will be arriving at the course before Friday morning MUST call so that the gates can be unlocked. Straw bedding will be provided. If you want shavings, you must provide your own.

### THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2017 NSA Spring Condition Book (center yellow section) for complete details of the new NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328)

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

ATTENTION TRAINERS: Pre-race vet exam for the horses is between 10:00 - 11:00 a.m. Please have someone to jog your horse(s). ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS

PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Credentials: Horsemen's NSA rear view mirror tags will be used for admittance - O.T.R. credentials will be available in the barn area or at will call the day of the races.

The Atlanta Steeplechase race course was inspected on April 2 by Clerk of Course, Jim Wayt.

Turf: Kingston Downs has benefitted from a mild winter, timely rains and is responding well to fertilizing and aeration. The fescue/bluegrass turf mix is well established and has continued to improve over time with good root structure and depth development. The course will be mowed regularly during this prime growing season creating a thick carpet like feel and appearance. There are some patches of other grasses (Bermuda and rye) and minimal spots of broad leaf weeds.

Smoothness: The course has been aerated and rolled. The ground is smooth throughout.

Compaction: Average: 135 (Firm)

Moisture: Average: 5 (Average) Note: the most recent rainfall was three days prior to the date of inspection. Kingston Downs will be irrigated as necessary until race day. Note: Kingston Downs continues to improve with age. The course condition on race day should be equal to or better than its high ratings in recent years.

## **Directions:**

***From I-75 South of Cartersville (Atlanta Area):*** Take I-75 North to Exit 293. Turn left onto US 411. Go 3.2 miles and turn right onto US 41/411 ramp to Rome. Go 2.9 miles through a couple of traffic signals. Turn right onto US 411 to Rome. Go 12 miles to Gore Spring Road on right. Follow directional signs. **Note: Georgia State Route 20 will be detoured Race Day. Do not use Exit 290.**

***From I-75 North of Cartersville:*** Take I-75 South to Exit #312. At the top of the ramp, turn right onto Route 53 to Rome (stay on 53 for approximately 25 miles). Turn left onto Rome Bypass. The Bypass will dead end into US 411. Turn left and after approximately 5 miles, turn left onto Bidy Road. Follow directional signs into the Steeplechase grounds.

***From Rome Area:*** Take US 411 North (toward Cartersville) to Bidy Road on left (approximately 5 miles from East Rome Bypass). Follow directional signs.

**NOTE: If coming from Atlanta, PLEASE do not use I-20.**
