ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATINGCIRCUMSTANCES.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

Turf: Established Bermuda over seeded with winter wheat and rye grass.

Smoothness: Good. Course was rolled and aerated mid-July.

Compaction: 9.6 (Good)

Moisture: 8.3 (Average Wet)

Notes: Course was drill seeded September 20 with winter wheat and broadcast rye grass. Recent rains have improved the surface. The course is irrigated.

New Updates: There is ongoing construction at the Aiken Horse Park (AHP). Due to this, there will be no paddock area, as in the past. Horses will be saddled at the barn and go directly to the track in order for riders up. Only trainers, grooms and jockeys will be allowed on the track at that time.

The AHP have built permanent stabling, which will be available for use at the race meet. You will be using the barns 6 and 7 on the far side, past the big tent. All other barns are prohibited for our use. The areas behind the barns can be used as the hot walk area.

We apologize for any inconvenience as we transition with the ongoing changes on the field.

Directions: I-20 to Exit 22/US-1 toward Aiken. Travel 5 miles. Turn left at 118/78 towards Williston. Travel 4 miles. This highway turns into Pine Log Road. Turn Right on Powderhouse Road. Horsemen's gate will be on the left.
