THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION: Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2017 NSA Fall Condition Book (center lavender section) for complete details of the new NSA Medication policy.

There will be a mandatory pre-race veterinarian exam. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race

No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted. Shoes will be inspected before each race.

ALL HORSES MUST BE SADDLED AT THE BARN, ASSEMBLE IN NUMERICAL ORDER IN THE BARN PADDOCK PRIOR TO EACH RACE AND PROCEED TO THE TOWER PADDOCK AS A GROUP. TRAINERS MUST ADHERE TO THE SCHEDULE THAT WILL BE POSTED IN THE BARN AREA.

All vans arriving Friday, Oct. 14 must use Gate 2 off Route 202. Security will continuously check Gate for late arrivals.

The Far Hills race course was inspected on October 9, 2017 by Clerk of Course, Dean Torsileri.

Turf: The entire turf course at Moorland Farm was aerated, slice seeded, and sand top dressed immediately after the Far Hills Race Meeting Association's Fall 2016 meet. Spring 2017 operations included divot repair, fertilization, rolling and aeration. Weekly mowing, weed control, and an aggressive IPM program have continued to keep the quality and consistency of the turf at the highest possible level. The turf is thick, lush, and has a clipped top out height of 6-8". There are a few thin areas in parts of the timber course close to the tree line on the backstretch. Ongoing weed control for this part of the course is in place.

Smoothness: The course has been rolled, aerated, and hand walked with root zone mix to fill any divots or cupping. The surface is smooth and consistent with a giving yet firm resiliency. There is NO vehicular traffic allowed on the course at any time.

Compaction: Readings taken with a Lang Penetrometer put the turf course at a reading of 100-120 (Good)

Moisture: 5-6 (Average)

Notes: Due to unfavorable weather conditions the turf courses did require supplemental irrigation during the late summer months.
