Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse

can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

The Aiken Steeplechase Association (ASA) will accept NSA pins in all areas EXCEPT the Guarantor Tent Party and all corporate tents. Lunch is provided for all participating Owners, Trainers and Riders only at the OTR tent. Your cooperation is appreciated.

PARKING: Please park all horse vans near the barns per usual. All other OTR vehicles, please park along the new green fencing directly across from the barn or the backside of the track along tree line. PLEASE DO NOT PARK INSIDE THE GREEN FENCING NEAR RAILSIDE AREAS.

The Aiken Steeplechase Association will provide lunch tickets for all grooms. Lunch will be provided by "The Track Kitchen" food truck. The truck will be located just beyond Barn 8 along the fence. Our Barn Manager, Donna Postma, will distribute tickets to grooms only. One ticket per groom includes a hamburger, hotdog or BBQ sandwich, fries and a drink. Cash concessions will be available to all others

The Aiken racecourse was inspected by Jill Thomas, Sam Slater, Lornie Forbes and Anne Pezzano on March 5, 2017.

Turf: Bermuda overseeded with field rye and rye grass.

Smoothness: Good. Course rolled after fall meet and will be rolled again before the races.

Compaction: 117 (Good) Firmer on car crossings which will be mulched for the races.

Moisture: 1.3 (Dry) Rain is in the forecast and sprinklers will be turned on.

Notes: After a dry winter, the turf is patchy in some spots, but the ground is smooth. Aggressive watering and spot over seeding will help.
