#### CAROLINA CUP - NOTICE TO HORSEMEN CONCERNING NEW NSA MEDICATION POLICY

All trainers running a horse on furosemide (Salix) at the Carolina Cup, that are not stabled in Barn B-1 or Barn B-2, must move their horses to the Portable Tent Stalls on the racecourse grounds by the prescribed time for Salix administration (4 hours prior to post time). Those horses will remain stabled in the Portable Tent Stalls until paddock time for their race.

Attention Trainers: By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Springdale Race Course for the Carolina Cup Races must have the following documents:

Requirements for out-of state horses:

1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and

2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

These documents will be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

There will be no training on the racecourse or around the perimeter of the racecourse.

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Attention Horsemen: Anyone wearing a Carolina Cup Horsemen's badge may use boxes I1-6 and J1-6 in the grandstand.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified. Tattoos are required for all horses with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

O/T/R's are encouraged to be on the grounds by 10:30 a.m. due to heavy traffic.

All participating owners, trainers, riders and grooms are encouraged to pick up Carolina Cup credentials from the Carolina Cup Racing Office PRIOR to 5:30 p.m. on Friday, March 31. The office will be open on Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. After 11:30 a.m. credentials will be left with Security in parking lot in front of the office. See attached notices regarding Carolina Cup credentials.

All post-race testing will be done in two stalls of the four-stall barn between Barn B and the Block Barn. The designated stalls face the Paddock. Please be advised that horsemen will need to make necessary arrangements for buckets and equipment to cool their horses out in this area if being tested. No horse will be allowed to go back to any outer barns: A, C, D, E until completion of testing.

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The Carolina Cup race course was inspected by Jeff Teter on March 17, 2017.

Turf: The turf consists of Bermuda grass that is brown and dormant. The course was drill seeded with winter rye grass back in September. Where there was sufficient moisture the rye grass looks good. Where there was not sufficient moisture the rye grass died. The course was mowed on March 15 and will not be mowed again. The dormant Bermuda was not mowed short like last spring and is thicker and more consistent throughout.

Smoothness: The course was aerated on March 6. The jumps on the backside are moved off the rail so they won't run over the same ground as the Colonial Cup. The course is fairly smooth throughout.

Compaction: 100-120 (good) throughout the race course.

Moisture: 2-6 (dry to average) throughout the race course but averaged 4 (average dry) throughout much of the course.

Update: The course received three-quarters of an inch of rain on March 22. Showers forecast for March 27-28, and thunderstorms on Friday, March 31<sup>s</sup>

### DIRECTIONS:

**From the North:** I-95 South to I-20 West. Take Exit 98 and turn right off the exit ramp onto US 521.

Follow US 521 (Broad Street) through town and turn left onto Knights Hill Road. Springdale Race Course is approximately 1 mile on the right.

**From the South:** I-20 East to Exit 92 (Lugoff/Camden). Turn right off the ramp and follow Route 601 North.

Merge right onto Route 1 North and follow through Lugoff over the Wateree River Bridge. Turn left onto Springdale Drive and turn right onto Knights Hill Rd. Springdale Race Course will be on the left.



## **Carolina Cup Racing Association Horsemen's Credentials and Aberdeen Luncheon Tent Tickets**

1. NSA pins are considered a general admission ticket. The NSA pin will allow access to the paddock, but will not allow access to the grandstand or the Post and Paddock Luncheon tent. NSA parking tags allow access to the Stable or Horsemen gates only.

2. Participating horsemen must pick up their credential envelopes in the Carolina Cup office the day prior to the races by 5:00pm. If you will not be arriving until race day, please call Heather Schmucker at the office (803) 432-6513 to make other arrangements for picking up credentials.

3. Participating horsemen will receive two (2) credentials, two (2) Post and Paddock Luncheon tent tickets, and one (1) parking credential without charge. Additional tickets for Post and Paddock can be purchased for \$50.00 each prior to race day. Please call at the office, in advance. **PLEASE NOTE:** The Post and Paddock Tent is located next to the paddock.

4. **Horsemen's Luncheon tent** - a complimentary luncheon tent, located behind the Jockeys Room, is available to all horsemen AND OFFICIALS from 11:30 am – 2:30 pm, serving lunch and a choice of ice tea/soft drinks/water.

5. Every person on the grounds must have an admission credential and every vehicle must have a parking tag.
