Attention Riders: There will be a mandatory jockeys meeting at 12:00 p.m. in the jocks room. There will be an officials meeting immediately following the jockeys meeting.

There will be a mandatory veterinarian exam before the races. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2017 NSA Spring Condition Book (center yellow section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Nicole Swinehart (803-427-4053)

IMPORTANT: No cars to park in van area. All cars are to park in designated owner trainer rider parking only. If cars are parked in the Van parking area they will be towed out immediately.

ALL HORSES WILL BE SADDLED IN THE BARN BEFORE EVERY RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SADDLING IN THE PADDOCK.

Foal papers are no longer required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

Horsemen: As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the races. This requirement will be strictly enforced. Please turn in a copy of your Coggins test to the HORSE IDENTIFIER (Brian Jarvis).

HORSEMEN PARKING: Parking for Owners/Trainers/Riders: Come in to van area and follow signs to new parking area.

A luncheon and cocktail party will be available for the participants of today's races (owners, trainers and riders) in the Official Luncheon Tent located near the stables and paddock.

NSA badges must be **VISIBLE** to expedite you through the Reserved Enclosure Gate. Owners, Trainers and riders - there are Member boxes available for your viewing of the races located on the top in front of the tents.

Drinks & fruit will be provided in the jocks room. There will be a groom's breakfast.

Schooling will not be permitted before, during, or after the races.

See Doug Fout for any problems that may arise.

Groom's award of \$100 for each race.

The Middleburg Spring race course was inspected by Doug Fout on April 7, 2017.

Turf: The turf consists of fescue.

Smoothness: The course is smooth throughout. It was rolled, chain harrowed after the Virginia Fall Races, and aerated on November 11, 2016.

Compaction: 76 (Yielding)

Moisture: 8 (Average Wet)

Notes: The course had 3/4" of rain on April and 1-1/4" of rain on April 6. The course will be mowed accordingly. The course is in great shape.
