THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2017 NSA Fall Condition Book (center lavender section) for complete details of the new NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Bonny Henderson (585-261-1372).

There will be a Jockeys meeting at the Jockeys' Tent at 12:00 pm; all riders MUST attend.

There will be an Officials meeting at 12:15 pm outside the Jockeys Tent.

There will be a \$100 award to the attendant of the best "turned out" horse in each race.

Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

NSA Shoe Policy: No raised toes, front or rear, will be permitted in any race. A raised toe is defined as an extension of the shoe by more than 1/16 of an inch. Stickers, caulks and turndowns are not permitted.

The Genesee Valley race course was inspected on October 9, 2017 by Marion Throne and Turner Boone.

Turf: Very thick turf, measuring about 6 inches

Smoothness: The course has been mowed three times this year with no hay equipment or livestock allowed. Fair hunting country.

Compaction: 100 (Good)

Moisture: 6 (Average)

Notes: Landing of the jumps and the track between fences have been aerated. We have had 2 inches of rain.
