New NSA Claiming Policy

Steeplechase At Charleston Course Report

The Charleston racecourse was inspected by Bud Brawner on October 30, 2017.

Turf: The turf on this course consists of a mixture of Semi-dormant Bermuda and broadcast seeded Rye grass that averaged 8 inches in height at the time of the inspection. Mowing before race day will be done to keep grass at around 6 inches in height.

Smoothness: This course has been fertilized, aerated and harrowed a number of times during the year, and the course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 90 - 100 (Good)

Moisture: Average 3 - 5 (Average Dry to Average)

Notes: Overall the course is in the best shape I have ever seen it. Due to hurricane Irma there was a small area of the racetrack that washed out on the home turn. This has been backfilled, sodded and over seeded. It should not be any cause for concern on race day. We will core aerate again before race day if it is necessary to keep the compaction rate below 110 (Good).
