There will be an officials meeting at the Stewards Stand at 12:15 p.m.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: The races are scheduled 40 minutes apart. This time table will be closely monitored throughout the day.

There will be a \$100 award given to the groom of the best turned out horse in each race.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: Only participating horsemen will be given race day credentials and access to the OTR tent. Tickets are available to purchase at [www.steeplechaseofcharleston.com](http://www.steeplechaseofcharleston.com).

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Chris Ernst. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

#### THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2017 NSA Fall Condition Book (center lavender section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

Attention Horsemen: All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

#### Attention Trainers:

By order of the South Carolina State Veterinarian, all racehorses, ponies, donkeys and any other horses entering the Springdale Race Course for the Steeplechase of Charleston must have the following documents:

Requirements for out of state horses:

1. CVI - Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (valid for 30 days) including description, date of negative EIA (Coggins) results, Lab and Accession number; and
2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

Requirements for in-state (South Carolina) horses:

1. Negative EIA (Coggins) test within 12 months

These documents will be checked by State Inspectors on race day.

RACE DAY TRAFFIC: Heavy traffic is to be expected on race day, please be advised to new traffic pattern and parking. PLEASE PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

OTR CREDENTIALS: Please pick up race day credentials in the horsemans area.

The Charleston racecourse was inspected by Toby Edwards, accompanied by Bud Brawner, on October 30, 2017.

Turf: The turf on this course consists of a mixture of Semi-dormant Bermuda and broadcast seeded Rye grass that averaged 8 inches in height at the time of the inspection. Mowing before race day will be done to keep grass at around 6 inches in height.

Smoothness: This course has been fertilized, aerated and harrowed a number of times during the year and the course is smooth throughout.

Compaction: 90 - 100 (Good)

Moisture: Average 3 - 5 (Average Dry to Average)

Notes: Overall the course is in the best shape I have ever seen it. Due to hurricane Irma there was a small area of the racetrack that washed out on the home turn. This has been backfilled, sodded and over seeded. It should not be any cause for concern on race day. We will core aerate again before race day if it is necessary to keep the compaction rate below 110 (Good).

Update: There is a high probability of rain Wednesday afternoon through Thursday afternoon.
