There will be an Officials Meeting at 12:15 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory pre-race vet check with Dr. Lisa Handy. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. ALL HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE (IF NOT ON LASIX) FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2018 NSA Spring Condition Book (center orange section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328).

All owners and trainers not using the veterinarians provided by the Aiken Steeplechase Association, please notify the Aiken office (803-648-9641) by Thursday, March 22.

REMINDER: Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races in claiming races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by his/her markings.

Turf: Broadcast and drill-seeded rye is thick and lush.

Smoothness: Course is smooth throughout; road crossings will be leveled and mulched.

Compaction: 89 (Good)

Moisture: 6.2 (Average)

Notes: The course was treated for fire ants on March 1 and fertilized on March 5. Warm weather in February and regular spring rains have improved the turf.
