Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one-time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

ATTENTION TRAINERS: Pre-race vet exam for the horses is between 10:00 - 11:00 a.m. Please have someone to jog your horse(s). ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. Kingston Downs was inspected on Thursday, March 29, 2018 by NSA Steward Rug Howard and Race Chairman Anthony-Scott Hobbs.

Turf: Kingston Downs has benefitted from 4.25 inches of rain in March. There is more rain forecasted for Wednesday. The fescue/blue grass turf mix is established, but in some areas of the track spotty. The course was mowed a month ago at 4 inches, and with the rain and warmer temperatures has a green appearance and has grown to 5-6 inches. There are some patches of other grasses (Bermuda and rye) and some spots of broad leaf weeds.

Smoothness: The course has not been aerated or rolled but is fairly smooth.

Compaction: Good: 105-120

Moisture: Average: 6-8

Directions:

From I-75 South of Cartersville (Atlanta area): Take I-75 North to Exit 293. Turn left on to US 411. Go 3.2 miles and turn right on to US41/411 ramp to Rome. Go 2.9 miles through a couple of traffic signals. Turn right on to US 411 to Rome. Go 12 miles to Gore Spring Road on right. Follow directional signs to parking. Note: Georgia State Route 20 will be detoured Race Day. **Do not use Exit 290.**

From I-75 North of Cartersville: Take I-75 South to Exit #312. At the top of the ramp, turn right on to Route 53 to Rome (stay on 53 for approximately 25 miles). Turn left on to Rome Bypass. The Bypass will dead end in to US 411. Turn left and after approximately 5 miles, turn left on to Gore Springs Road. Follow directional signs to parking.

From the Rome area: Take US 411 North (toward Cartersville) to Gore Springs Road on left (approximately 5 miles from the East Rome Bypass). Follow directional signs to parking.
