Foal papers are not required to be on file with the Horse Identifier at the races providing the horse can be properly identified; and tattoos are required for all horses, with a one time exception providing the horse can be identified by its markings. All scratches must be made no later than one hour prior to post time for the first race.

A pre-race veterinary exam is required of each entry beginning at 1:30 p.m. at the stable area by Drs. Rachel Westerlund and Cooper Williams. Bandages are not permitted during the examination. ALL HORSES NOT ON LASIX MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 2 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THE FIRST RACE FOR THE PRE-RACE VET CHECK UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE STEWARDS FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES. LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

Scratches are due no later than 2:15 p.m. with the Clerk of Scales, Jake Chalfin.

There will be a mandatory meeting of apprentice jockeys at 12:00 p.m. at the Stewards Stand.

There will be a mandatory jockeys meeting at 2:15 p.m. with the Stewards at the riders tent. An Officials meeting will be held immediately following the jockeys meeting in the paddock.

The Grand National Steeplechase will not permit any type of advertising on a rider or a horse running in any race of the day.

Special Events Medical Services (SEMS) provides field trauma support and works within the parameters of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS). Note: SEMS utilizes Gator vehicles specifically modified for field trauma use. A team of qualified physicians is present to supervise medical activities and to perform examinations following a fall.

Western Run Plate is run between blue and white flags.

Update: The Grand National race course was inspected on April 16, 2018 by Priscilla Hoblitzell.

Turf: The turf is in excellent and even condition throughout. Recent warm weather and rainfall have combined to encourage spring grass.

Smoothness: The majority if the course is very smooth. Cambridge rolling and harrow of entire course is done.

Compaction: Readings throughout between 6 - 10 on the Lang Penetrometer (Average to Yielding).

Moisture: The Course received a soaker rain in the past twelve hours. The weather for the week prior had a mix of unusually warm days and plenty of wind and the ground had become firm. This latest rainfall has come at an ideal time and provided an even and slow soak. There are no spots that would be particularly deep.

Notes: Course is flagged with only a few exceptions for minor fence adjustments. Course walkers are welcome and invited to communicate areas of concern and needed attention.
